Ableton have announced that version 9 of their popular Live software will be released soon. The new version includes a number of evolutionary features, new plugs-ins and instruments.

Live 9 will remain as two main versions, Live Standard and Live Suite, the latter including many more instruments, drum loops and sounds. Live Suite 9 will also now include Max for Live for free, previously a 199 euro addition.

New users can purchase Live 8 at 25% off and receive a free upgrade to Live 9 when it is released.

Existing users can upgrade from Live 8 Standard to Live 8 Suite and receive a free upgrade to Live 9 Suite including Max For Live for 254 euros.
