Stage Research announce RF Scanner

Stage Research, makers of SFX, RF Guru and Show Builder, have announced their latest product, RF Scanner. Using external hardware (Lectrosonics VR, RF Explorer, and WiNRADiO 305 are compatible), the software will compile a survey of the RF environment, and can export the results as a .CSV file.

The software is available for \$39, then on a subscription basis thereafter, currently \$19pa. The software runs under Windows but will happily run under Parallels, VMWare, etc on a Mac.
