Sisters with Transistors



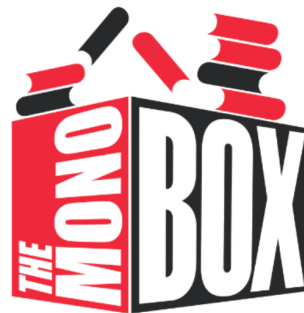
